

WARM HEARTH VILLAGE (WHV) SINGLE-STREAM RECYCLING GUIDELINES

Effective July 1, 2020

- WHV Waste Stream is split into 2 parts:
 - **Single-Stream Recycle**
 - **Trash**
 - DO NOT MIX THESE.

- **Single-Stream Recycle (NO bagging of any sort, combine loose in recycle containers.)**
 - **Paper Products-Dry**
 - Newspaper, Magazines, Office paper, Paper-backed books, and Junk mail.
 - Envelopes without liners, but cellophane windows are OK.
 - Cardboard Boxes (Cereal, Pizza, Gift, etc. Boxes) empty without liners or bags. Break them down. Clean, Stained pizza cardboard is OK.
 - Corrugated Cardboard, shipping, and packing, boxes.
 - Place in Recycle Containers, if flattened and if they fit without jamming.
 - Do not leave cardboard on the ground in the recycle area. They get wet and are costly to dispose.
 - Larger cardboard should be broken down and taken to the Blue Recycle Trailer in the Showalter parking lot.
 - **NO** shredded paper.
 - **NO** plastic bags.
 - **Glass-Empty**
 - Bottles and Jars, preferred without caps.
 - **Cans-Empty**
 - Aluminum Beverage Cans. Attached tabs OK.
 - Steel and Tin cans without lids unless firmly attached. No separate lids allowed.
 - **Plastic Containers-Empty**
 - **ONLY** ♻️ (PETE) & ♻️ (HDPE) Bottles, Jugs, and “Food Containers”.
 - Bottles and Jugs preferred with lids (don’t check the recycle code of the lids.).

- Acceptable “Food Containers” are defined as ♻️ or ♻️ plastic unit that has a lid cover.
- No ♻️ or ♻️ plastic trays.
- ♻️ or ♻️ drinking cups are not acceptable! These are NOT “Food Containers”.
- Other ♻️ or ♻️ plastics not acceptable.
- If you can’t find or read the ♻️ or ♻️ recycle symbols, ***Throw it in the Trash.***

- ***Trash (Preferred in plastic bags.)***
 - When you follow these Single-Stream Recycling Guidelines, then anything not on the above list goes in the ***Trash.***

• **UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS IN SINGLE-STREAM RECYCLE**

Note: Contamination of the Single-Stream will raise disposal costs and result in the entire “LOAD” being sent to **Trash.**

- Paper towels, napkins, and tissues
- Jar, bottle, or can tops unless attached to the containers
- Cat food cans
- Composite containers such as cardboard containers with metal bottoms and/or rims
- Aluminum foil or aluminum disposable cook pans or sheets
- Hard cover books
- Styrofoam of any form!
- Shredded paper-bagged or not
- Used aerosol spray cans
- Plastic bags
- Bagging of any kind in Single-Stream recycle
- Foods or liquid
- Hoses, wires, chains, or cords.
- Electronics

IF IN DOUBT, THROW IT OUT!
